

Biography of Qiwei Qin



Qin Qiwei, born in Oct 21, 1964, Ph D., Professor, currently serves as the dean of College of Marine Sciences, South China Agricultural University. He has also earned the honors of “New Century Excellent Talents” of Ministry of Education, the Distinguished Young Scholars of National Science Foundation of China, Government Special Allowance (GSA) granted by the State Council, and the “Hundred Talents Program” of Chinese Academy of Sciences.

Prof Qin has mainly engaged in studies on marine microbiology and aquaculture bio-security in Japan National Research Institute of Aquaculture, National University of Singapore, Tokyo University of Marine Science and Technology, Sun Yat-sen University, and South China Sea Institute of Oceanology, Chinese Academy of Sciences in recent years, and made a series of creative academic achievements in the field of marine fish virology, particularly on a novel ranavirus of Singapore iridovirus (SGIV), molecular and cellular fish immunology, genomics, proteomics, etc. He has successively finished over more than ten major research projects in China and published more than 80 papers in international peer reviewed important academic journals, 3 books, and made over 50 academic presentations on international academic conferences.
